service from John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK). The seasonal nonstop service from JFK to PSP will begin in November with service every Saturday, continuing through April 23, 2016. In addition, Virgin America will be offering nonstop flights every Wednesday beginning March 16, 2016 through April 2016.

American Airlines will provide a daily non-stop from Chicago-O'Hare International Airport (ORD) beginning October 5, 2015.

WestJet continues its commitment to Greater Palm Springs with increased service from Toronto beginning October 27, 2015. WestJet also provides year round, nonstop service from Calgary and Vancouver; and seasonal, nonstop service from Edmonton and Winnipeg.

Air Canada offers nonstop service from Vancouver (YVR) on leisure subsidiary Air Canada Rouge. The flight will operate on Thursdays, Fridays and Sundays from December 17, 2015 through April 10, 2016.
