

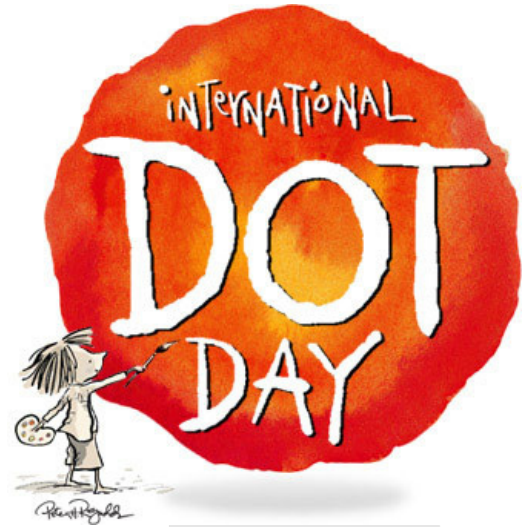
# Make Your Mark

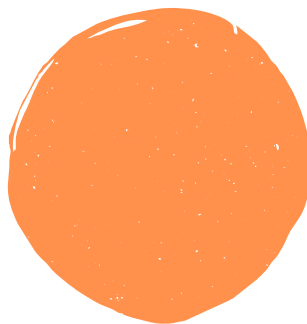


## Things You Can Do For Dot Day

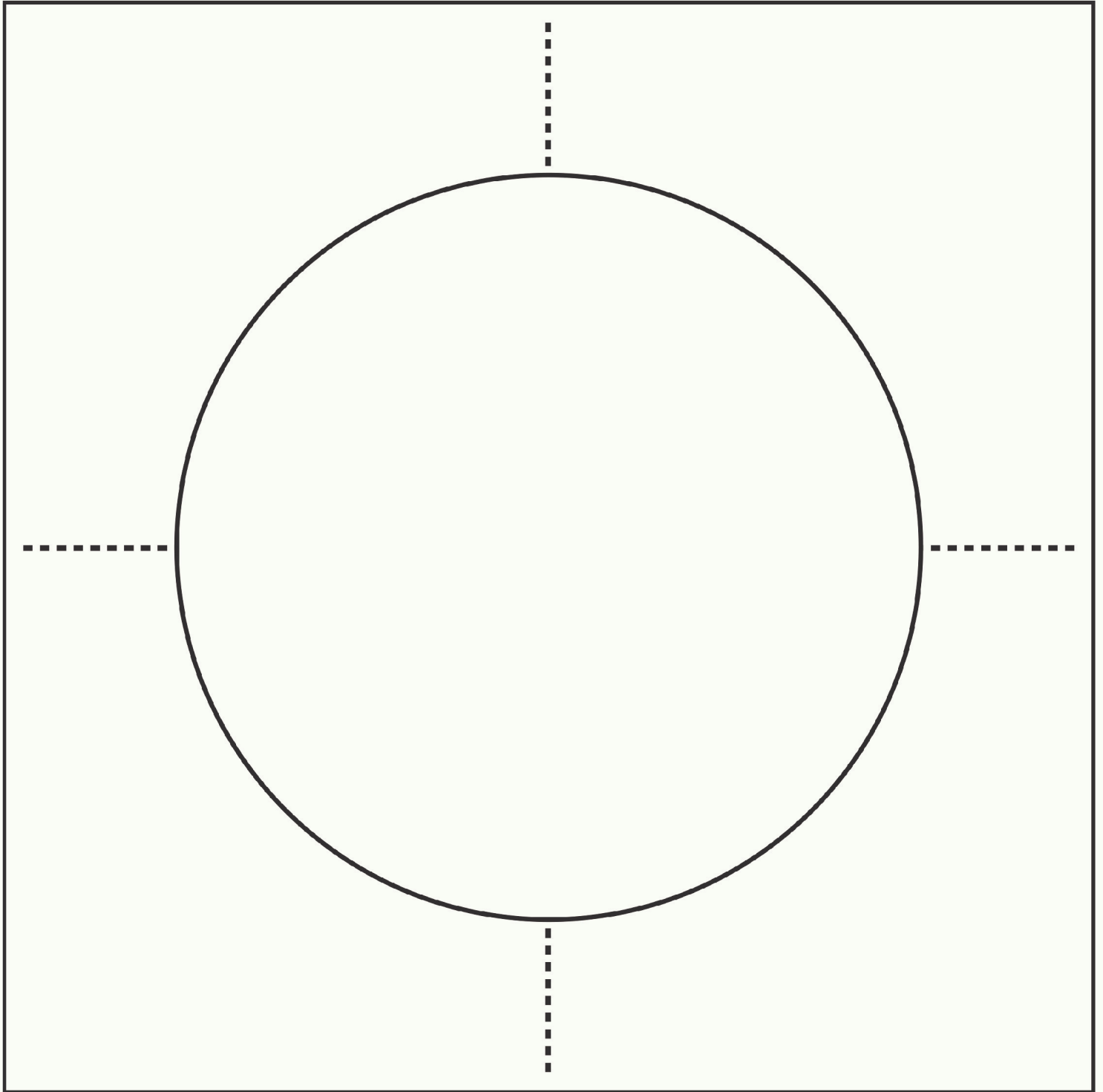
1. Read **The Dot** by Peter H. Reynolds.


