The 2nd Annual Cathedral City Hot Air Balloon Festival will be a kaleidoscope of color, sound, art and enjoyment for the whole family on Valentine's Day Weekend, February 12-14, 2016. We kick-off the events with a "Hot Breakfast and Balloons" on Friday, February 12th at 6:00 a.m. from Big League Dreams Sports Park at the corner of Dinah Shore Drive and Date Palm Drive. Attendees will enjoy an American Breakfast and watch nearly 30 Hot Air Balloons inflate on three ball fields as they prepare to ascend and race across the Coachella Valley to win prizes. Tickets are \$10 per person plus a processing fee and can be purchased at www.HotAirBalloonFest.com.

On Saturday morning, attendees have two options to enjoy the balloon festival. At 7 a.m., capture the perfect picture as you watch more than 20 Hot Air Balloons inflate and mass ascend above the beautiful Westin Mission Hills Golf Resort & Spa, our title sponsor. Those looking for even greater excitement can elect to ride along with the pilots for a once in a lifetime opportunity to sail with so many other balloons in the greater palm springs area. Admission is free to watch, ride tickets can be purchased at www.HotAirBalloonFest.com.

LAST WEEK TO PROVIDE INPUT ON LONG-TERM REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN



Elected officials and residents from throughout Southern California are being asked to provide input on the Draft 2016-2040 Regional Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy (RTP/SCS), prior to adoption by the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) in April 2016.

Every four years, SCAG prepares an updated RTP/SCS for the six-county region it serves: Imperial, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura. The RTP/SCS details how the region will address its transportation and land use challenges while meeting federal air quality emissions standards and state greenhouse gas reduction targets.

Ultimately, the vision of the RTP/SCS is to improve the quality of life for the region's residents by making the best transportation and land use choices to meet the needs of a growing population and changing demographics over the next 25 years. The SCAG region will be home to 22.1 million people in 2040 – up 3.8 million from 2012. Improving mobility is essential if we are to accommodate both the increase in people and the job growth needed to sustain our economic viability.

Economic disparity is a major challenge as well. One in five adults and one in four children in the SCAG region live in poverty. In order to fix that, we need to attract more businesses, create more jobs and bridge the gap between where lower-income families live and where the employment opportunities are.

The 2016 RTP/SCS identifies \$556.5 billion in transportation investments that will improve mobility and reduce congestion, improve air quality and create economic opportunity.


Friends of the Library - Pancake Fundraiser by Applebee's
