Three New Events Coming to Cathedral City This Fall

The City of Cathedral City is excited to announce three brand new events coming this fall. They include Cinema Diverse, Desert Treasure Hunt, and FallFest.

Cinema Diverse (Palm Springs LGBTQ Film Festival)

Cathedral City's Desert Cinemas will become the valley's second theatre to screen films as part of Cinema Diverse: The Palm Springs LGBTQ Film Festival, marking another record year of growth for the niche film festival. Now in its 9th year, the Festival has expanded beyond the Camelot Theatre in Palm Springs to include Cathedral City. The festival is one of three niche film festivals operated by The Palm Springs Cultural Center, which was founded in 2007 by local philanthropists Ric and Rozene Supple.
