Garage Sales

As spring arrives and the weather cools, it's a great time to have a garage sale. If you're considering having a garage sale, please keep these things in mind:

- A garage sale permit is required, at a cost of \$25, and may be obtained at City Hall during normal office hours (Monday – Thursday, 7:00 am – 6:00 pm).
- Each residence may have up four (4) garage sales per year, with a minimum of ninety (90) days between each sale.
- A garage sale can be requested for up to three consecutive days, and are allowed between the hours of 7:00 am – 6:00 pm.
- Two (2) signs are provided with each permit. Additional signs may be purchased for \$5.00 each. No other types of signs are permitted. All signs must be removed at the end of the sale.

- Legal documents
- Medical records
- Financial statements
- Accounting files/records
- Personnel files
- Payroll records
- Bank statements
- Tax records

- Photographs
- Credit card documents

You're not limited to the items listed – bring all your sensitive documents.

TIPS:

- You do not need to remove paper clips, staples, file folders, report covers, envelopes or binder clips from your documents.
- You can bring your documents in boxes or plastic bags.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Limited to Cathedral City **RESIDENTS** only.
- Be prepared to show proof of residency or bring this postcard to the event.
- Limit 5 banker sized boxes per resident or household.
- **No businesses allowed.**
- Remove all trash items from your boxes or bags!
- Items like pens, pencils or regular household trash cannot be shredded.

MORE:

- Your documents will be shredded on site – you will be able to witness the entire process.
- Arrive early – once the shredding truck is filled to capacity the event will end.
- This is a free event – there is no charge to shred your documents.
