Council Budget Prioritizes Park Improvements

In anticipation of the City Council Goal-Setting meeting this past January, the Cathedral City Parks and Community Events Commission, under the leadership of Chairperson Danny Lee and including Commissioners Gary Marshall, Stephen Vericker, Chip Yarborough and Fergus



Currie, developed a document identifying priorities for improvements to the Cathedral City parks.

During their goal-setting session on January 30, 2021, Council developed a goal to support Parks and Community Events Commission priorities for improvements to our Parks facilities. When Council was reviewing the proposed budget for Fiscal Years 21-22 and 22-23, they considered a Park Improvement and Maintenance Plan prepared by Finance and Engineering and Public Works staff designed to address the Commission's priorities for improving our Parks facilities. The result is that the budget approved by the City Council allocated \$2.1 million for parks improvements. The following items were included in the approved budget:

Panorama Park

- Repair and renew safety surfaces on play equipment
- Repair sidewalks at the SE corner of the park alongside Avenida Maravilla and Tachevah.
- Repair and restore tennis court fencing and repair and restripe tennis court surfacing
- Install security gates on restrooms and improve restroom facilities
- Improvements to meet standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) including concrete and asphalt surfacing, bathroom facilities, benches and tables and baseball seating
- · Install a shade structure over the play equipment
- · Extend the basketball court to full size

Century Park

- Repair and renew safety surfaces on play equipment
- · Repair and restore tennis court fencing and repair and restripe tennis court surfacing
- Install security gates on restrooms and improve restroom facilities
- Improvements to meet standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) including concrete and asphalt surfacing, bathroom facilities, benches and tables
- · Install a shade structure over the play equipment
- · Add additional light poles along with electric signage

· Resurface the parking lot

Ocotillo Park

- · Repair and renew safety surfaces on play equipment
- · Repair and install two equipment items and surfacing related to circuit training

Dennis Keat Soccer Park

- · Repair and install eight equipment items and surfacing related to circuit training
- · Renovate and repair turf area adding sand and removing divots
- Install security gates on restrooms and improve restroom facilities
- Improvements to meet standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) including concrete and asphalt surfacing, bathroom facilities, benches and tables

Dog Parks

- Construct a dog park within Panorama Park
- Construct a dog park adjacent to the new Fire Station on Buddy Rogers in downtown

Staff are currently working on the plans, designs, bid specifications and contract development necessary to complete the identified work which will be completed in phases over the upcoming year. It will be exciting to see our parks improved so that they can be enjoyed even more by the people of our community.


