Council Discusses Joining Desert Recreation District

During a special meeting on September 1, 2021, the City Council discussed the possibility of Cathedral City annexing into the Desert Recreation District (DRD). The boundaries of the DRD currently include the cities of Coachella, Indio, La Quinta, Indian Wells, Palm Desert, and part of Rancho Mirage along with unincorporated areas of



Riverside County including the communities of Thousand Palms and Bermuda Dunes. The DRD offers many programs to residents within its service area including parks, swimming pools and community centers where a broad array of special interest classes, sports and other recreational opportunities are provided. Residents of Cathedral City may currently sign up for DRD classes, leagues and other programs but must pay a higher non-resident registration fee.

For several years, the City Council has had a goal of improving parks and recreation opportunities available to Cathedral City residents and has considered joining the DRD to be a viable option to achieve that goal. Among the benefits to Cathedral City residents of joining the DRD are the following:

- Improved maintenance of existing parks including capital replacement funding so that playground equipment, restroom facilities, sports fields and other parks facilities can be replaced when they reach the end of their useful life
- Addressing existing deferred maintenance issues at the parks such as refurbishing turf areas,
 athletic fields and other costly maintenance items that have been deferred over the years
- Operating and maintaining new parks facilities including a proposed community park in the Dream Homes neighborhood and a new dog park
- Operating the pool at Cathedral City High School for public use during the summer each year
- · Access to the programs, classes and activities offered by the DRD at lower resident rates
- Development of a community recreation center in Cathedral City so that the programs, classes and other recreational opportunities provided across the DRD will be available right here in our city

Much work remains to be done and many decisions remain to be considered before the Council's goal of offering improved parks and recreation services to our residents through an organization such as DRD can be realized. Over the next few months, city and DRD staff, elected officials from the City and the DRD, the Parks and Community Events commission and others will be working to

develop a proposal that can ultimately be considered by Cathedral City voters. There will be many opportunities for the public to be involved as we seek your input and involvement.

Preliminary plans point toward a ballot question to be placed before the voters in November 2022 to authorize joining the DRD and providing the necessary tax revenue to support it. 


