Three Special Events on October 2nd Kick-off the 2021-22 Season

Are you ready to get out of the house and start enjoying Special Events again? There are three events happening in Cathedral City on Saturday, October 2nd to kick-off the 2021-2022 Season. They are the monthly Shred Event to Stop Identity Theft, Fun-O-Rama Celebrating Clean Air Day at Ocotillo Park, and the annual Coachella Valley Battle in the Desert boxing tournament.

SHRED EVENT:

To help STOP identity theft and as a service to its residents, the City of Cathedral City is hosting a FREE Document Shredding Event on Saturday, October 2, 2021 starting at 8:00 a.m. and will conclude by 9:00 a.m. The Shredding Events are scheduled on the first Saturday of each month, October thru May, and are located near the Festival Lawn at 68510 East Palm Canyon Drive.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, each person should remain in their vehicles, wear a facial covering, and place the items to be shredded in an easily accessible area of their vehicle, such as the trunk of a car.

Examples of documents that can be shredded are:

Legal documents, medical records, financial statements, accounting files/records, personnel files, payroll records, bank statements, tax records, contracts, receipts/invoices, cancelled checks, photographs, and credit card documents.

You will be able to witness the entire shredding process from your vehicle.

FUN-O-RAMA:

Councilmember Nancy Ross, Volunteer of the Year Sue Townsley, City's Environmental Conservation Division, SCRAP Gallery, the Cathedral City Boys and Girls Club, Cathedral City Arts Commissioners, the Cathedral City Parks and Community Events Commission, and the Desert Recreation District have teamed up to provide a family fun day event at Ocotillo Park on Saturday, October 2, 2021 from 9 am to 1 pm.

Fun-O-Rama encapsulates the charm of an old-fashioned family fun day with field day activities such as sack races, box relay, cornhole toss, bean bag toss, ring toss, T-ball hit and running of bases, basketball dunk, and cupcake walks. It will also include a Tug-of-War competition between our fire and police departments.

Beyond field day activities, Fun-O-Rama celebrates Clean Air Day and offers art projects for kids, photo booth with a fall theme, and a Sunline Clean Bus display.

The free event also provides free snacks and drinks for families (while supplies last) from 9 am to 1 pm.

COACHELLA VALLEY BATTLE IN THE DESERT

The annual amateur boxing tournament, Coachella Valley Battle in the Desert, returns on Saturday, October 2, 2021 starting at 6 pm on the Festival Lawn in Downtown Cathedral City. Certified by USA Boxing, the tournament pits regional public safety personnel against each other as they compete in the sport of boxing.

The outdoor event will offer entertainment along with several food and beverage options for purchase. Gates will open at 5:30 pm and the first bout will occur at 6:30 pm. Tickets are available by calling Police Officer Jesus Gonzalez at (760) 335-8895.

Attendees should know that facial coverings should be worn at the event when social distancing around those outside of your household is not possible. Exceptions to the rule include when eating and drinking.




